
The MNPS Encore Program values the creative, emotional, & social needs of a diverse population of gifted & academically talented students through the engagement of a rigorous curriculum.

Students are referred for assessment by school data teams based on their reading/math abilities & gifted characteristics.
Assessments take place in the spring.



New for 17 - 18! Every 2nd grade student in a traditional MNPS school will be universally screened for Encore in late October.



Students are referred for assessment based on their academic performance.
Assessments take place in the fall.

Intellectually Gifted

Parents, guardians, & others can request that students be screened for Intellectual Giftedness at any point in the school year. Ask your child's teacher for a Support Team meeting.

FAST FACTS

- K-8 Encore classes are available at every MNPS elementary & middle school!
- Pre-K Encore classes are available at Robertson Academy & Ross Early Learning Center.
- Students must be identified as intellectually gifted or academically talented in order to qualify for the Encore Program.
- Encore classes are taught by Advanced Academics Resource Teachers (AARTs) who specialize in gifted & talented education.
- Encore classes meet during the school day at your child's school for free.
- Encore students study interdisciplinary, inquiry-based units.

of Gifted Students

- Unbridled curiosity
- Exceptional memory
- · Committed to projects
- Eagerness to know "how" & "why"
- Vast wealth of general knowledge
- Keen understanding of the ways humans interact
- Sensitivity to the emotions of others
- Able to grasp abstract concepts
- Pays attention to details when making observations
- · Advanced sense of humor
- Early ability to hone in on specific interests
- Extensive vocabulary
- Ability & preference to hold conversation with adults
- Able to learn quickly (1-2 repetitions)
- Impatience with repetitive tasks
- Frequent elaboration in art & writing
- · Perfectionist tendencies
- · Able to make unusual connections
