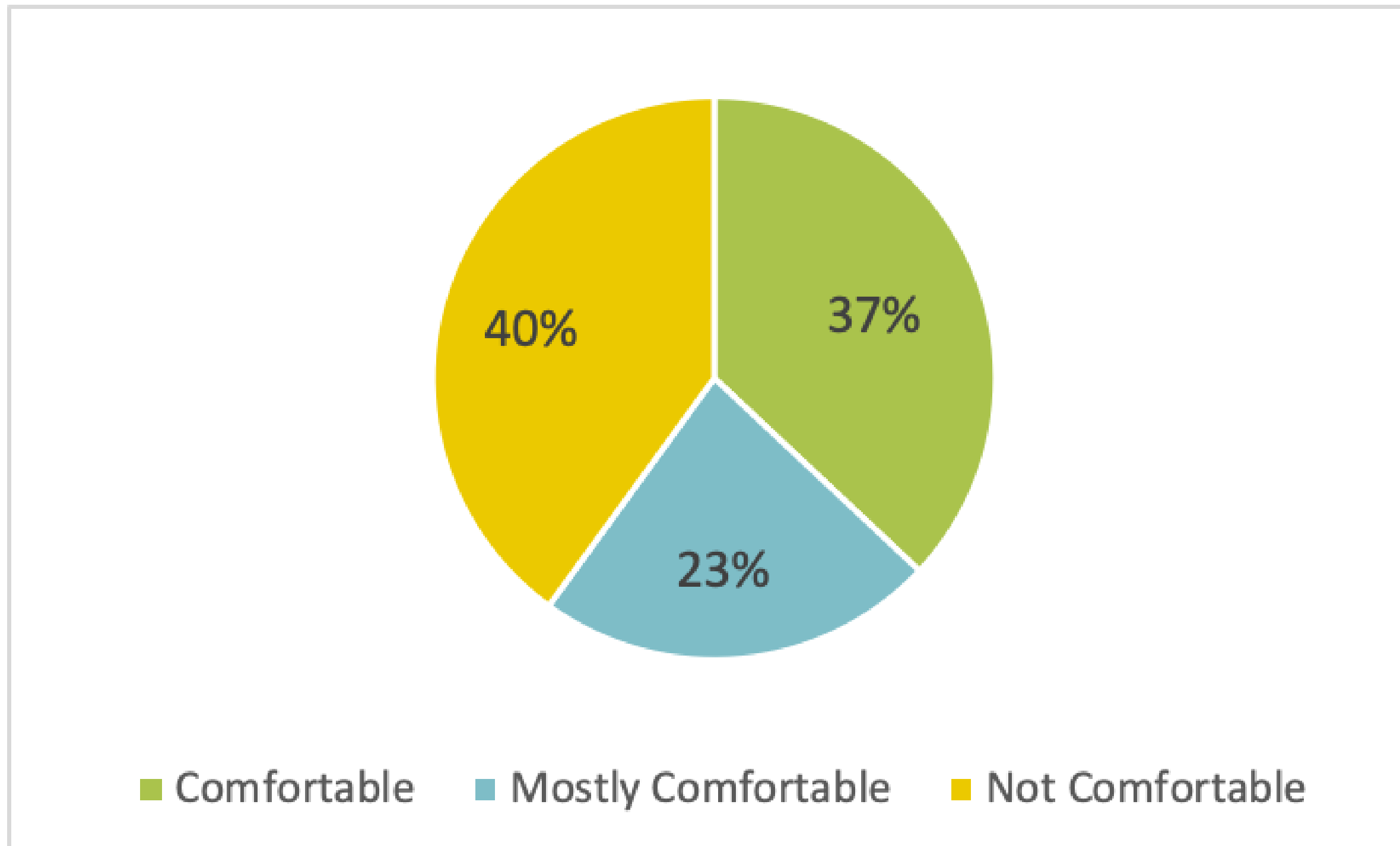

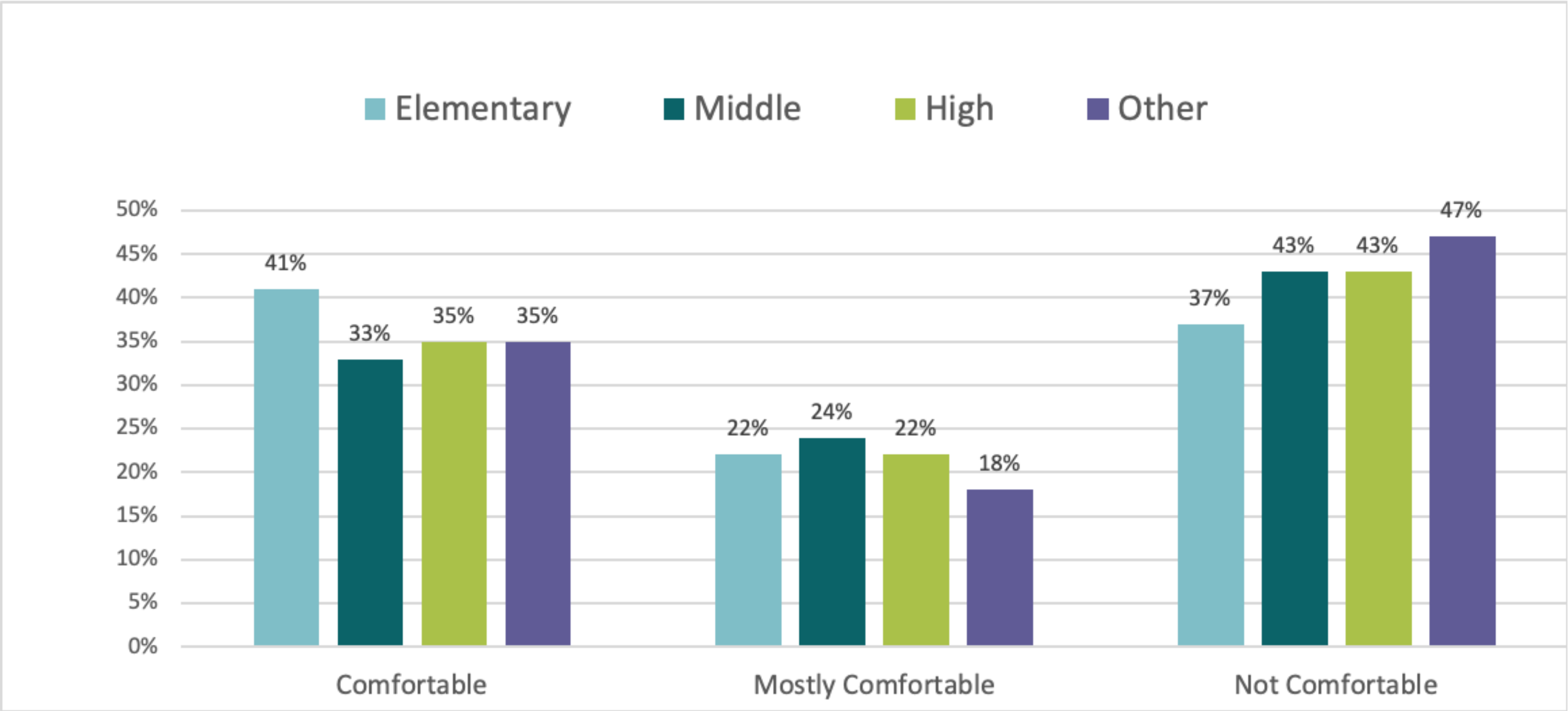

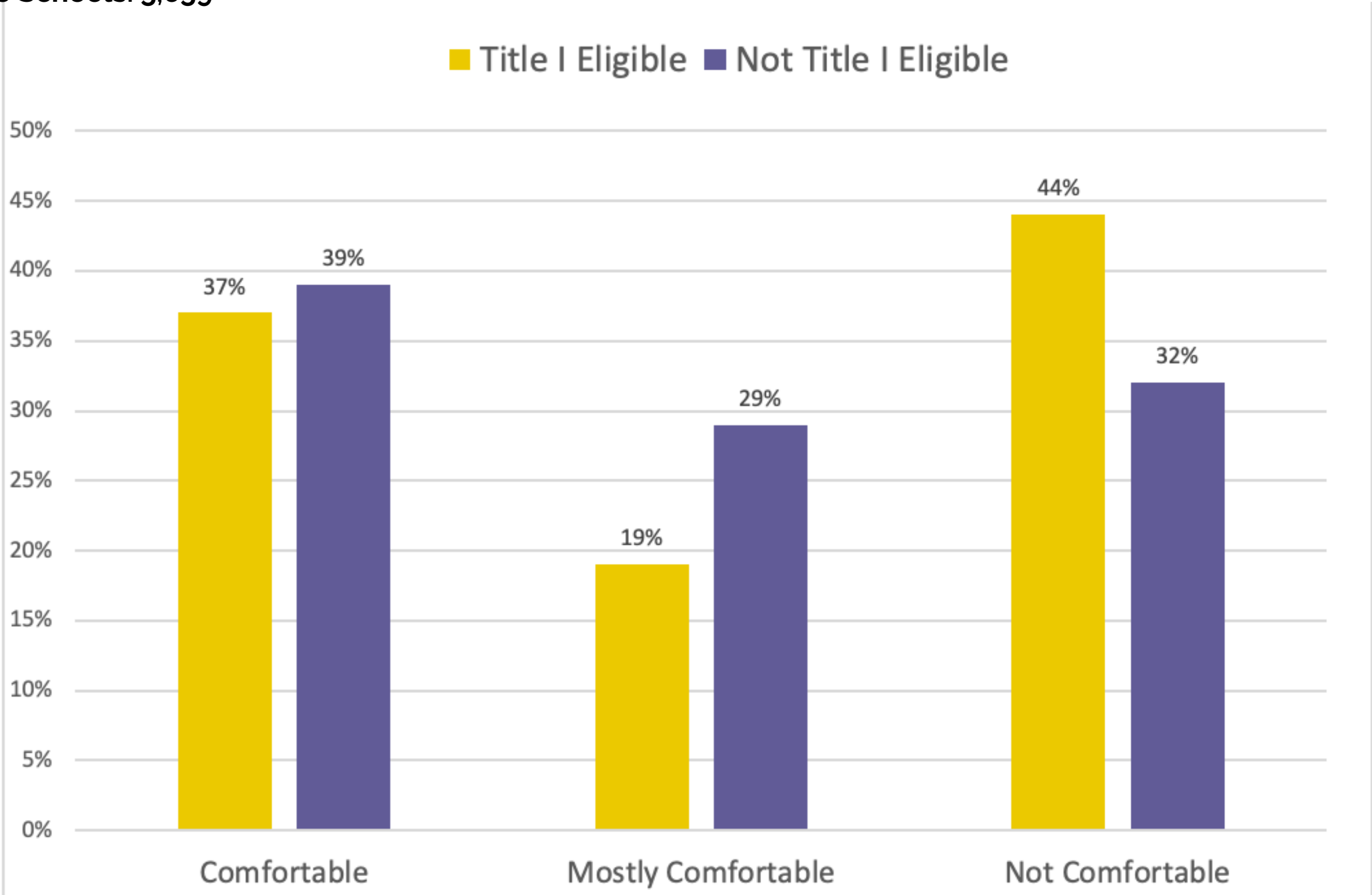

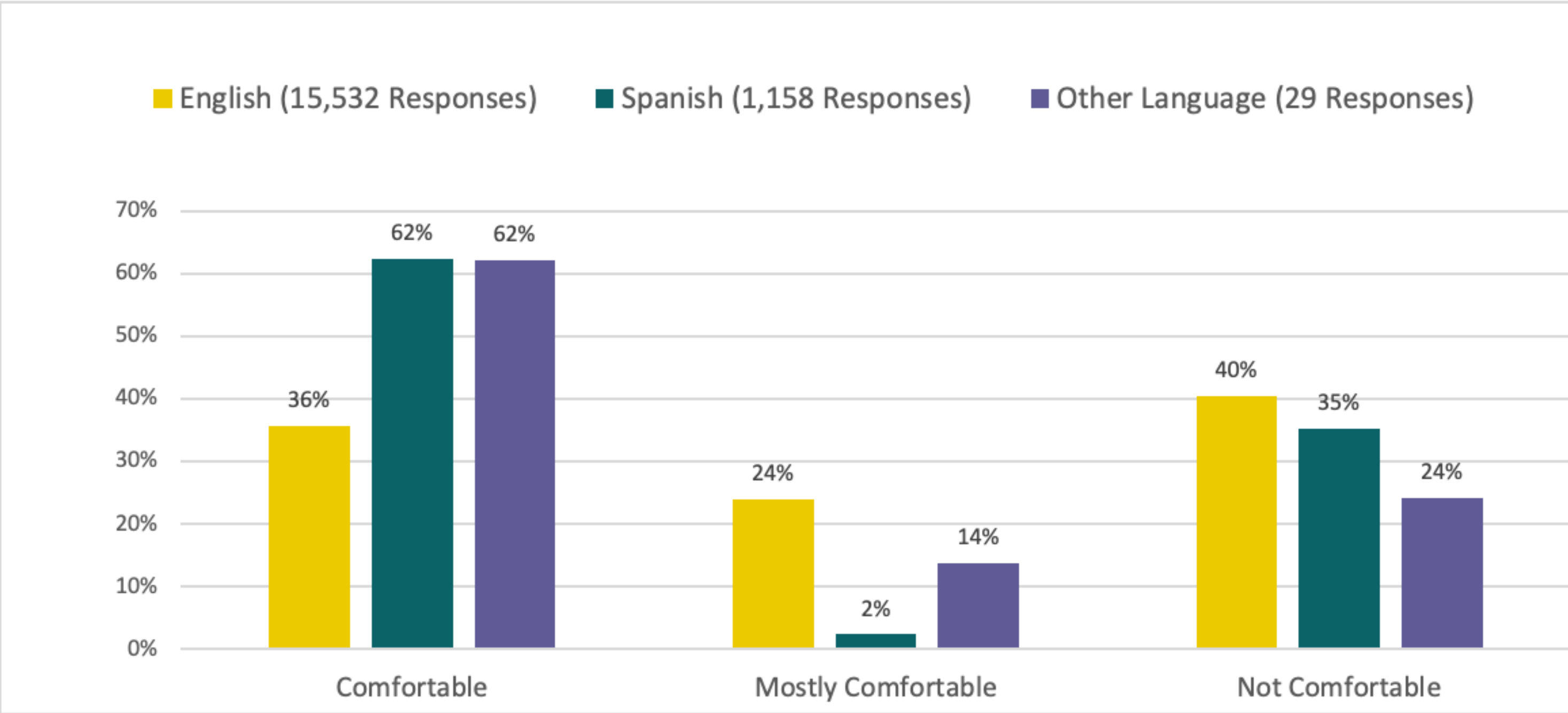

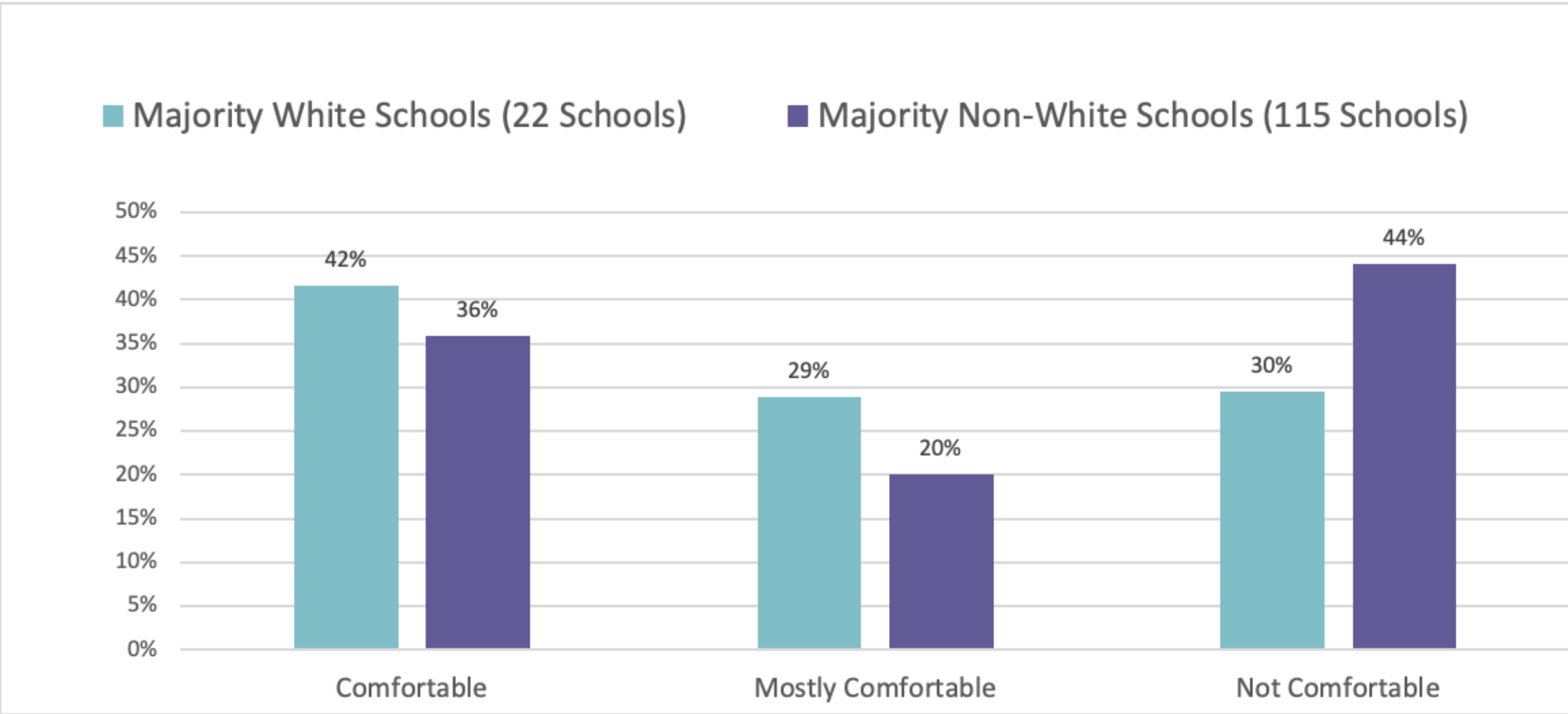

## Breakdown by Preferred Language



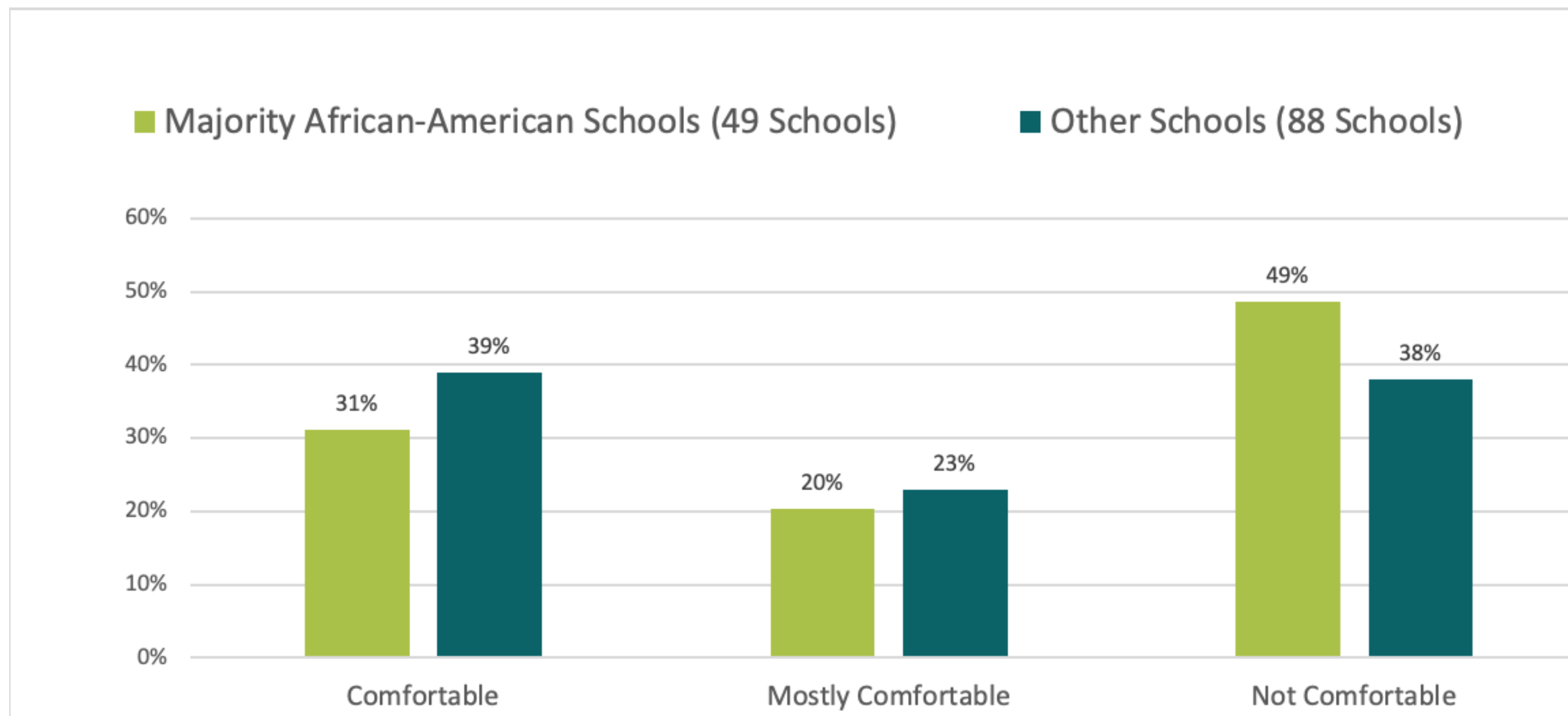

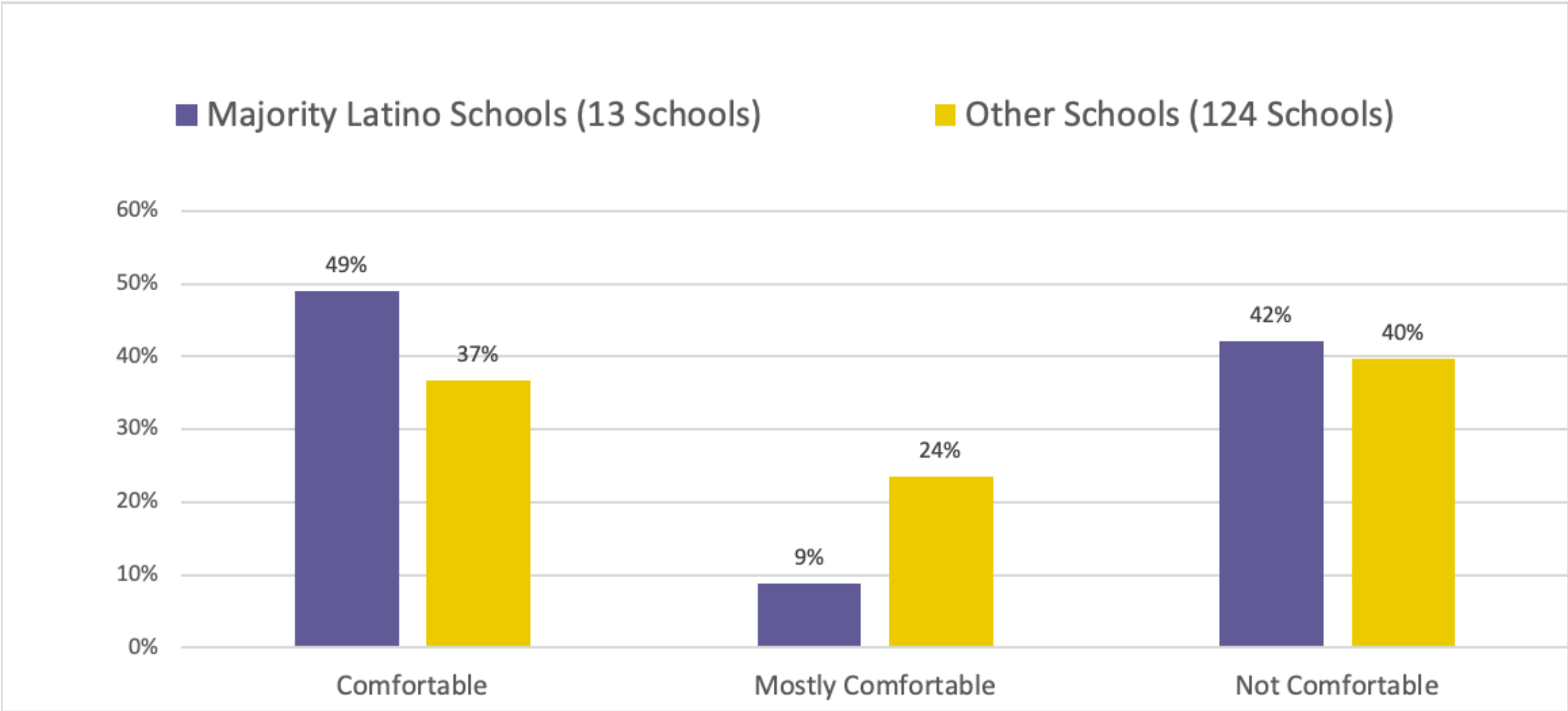

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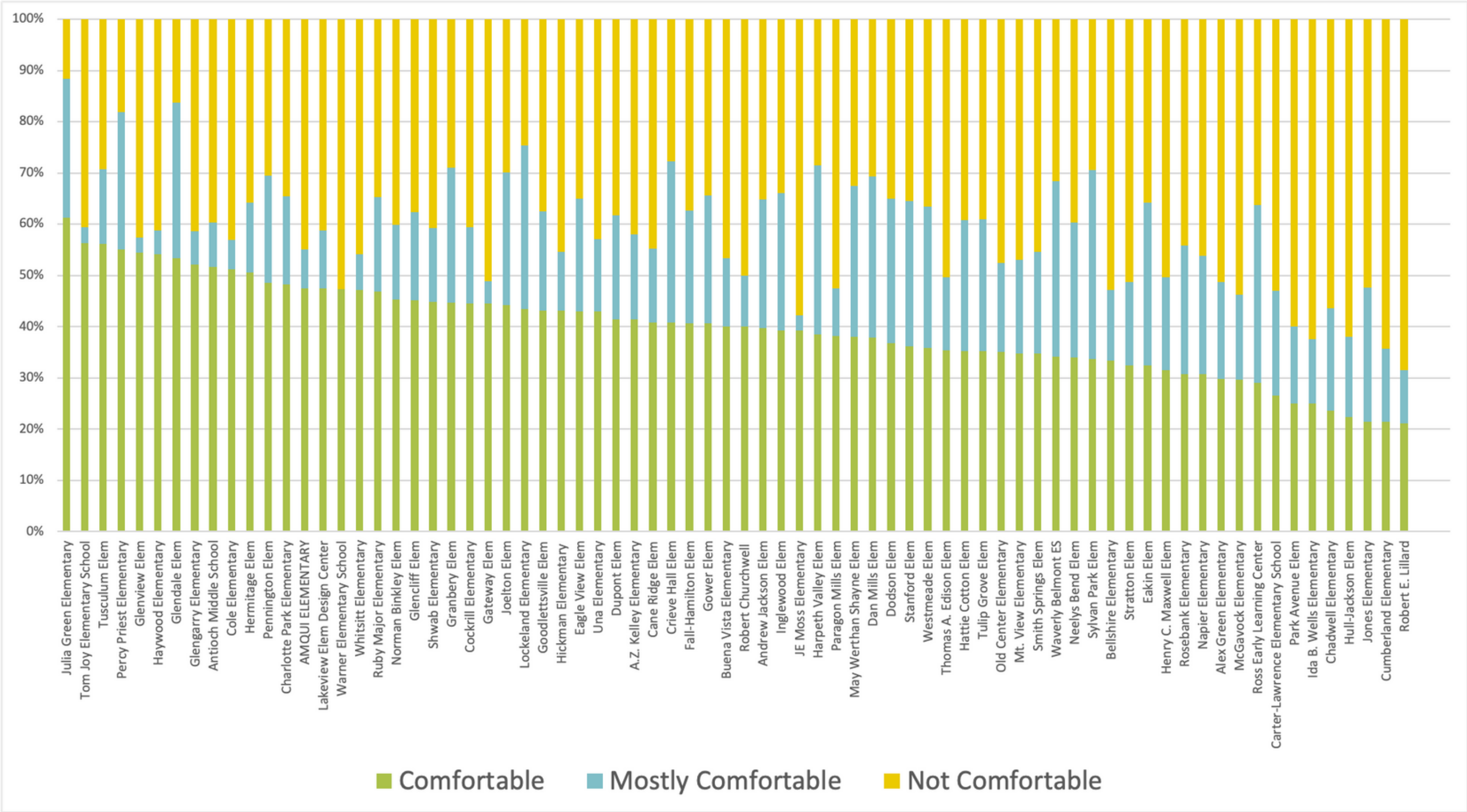
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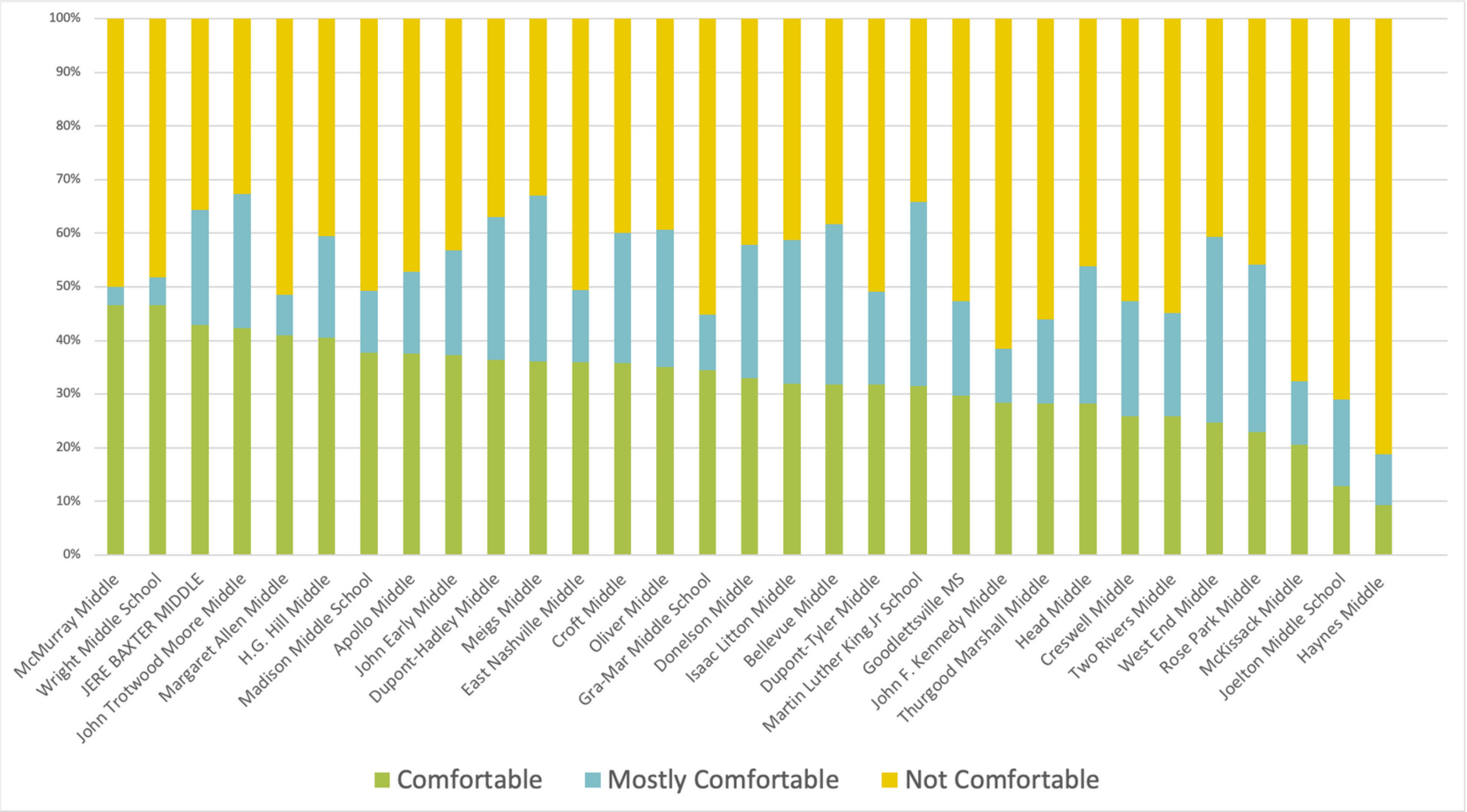

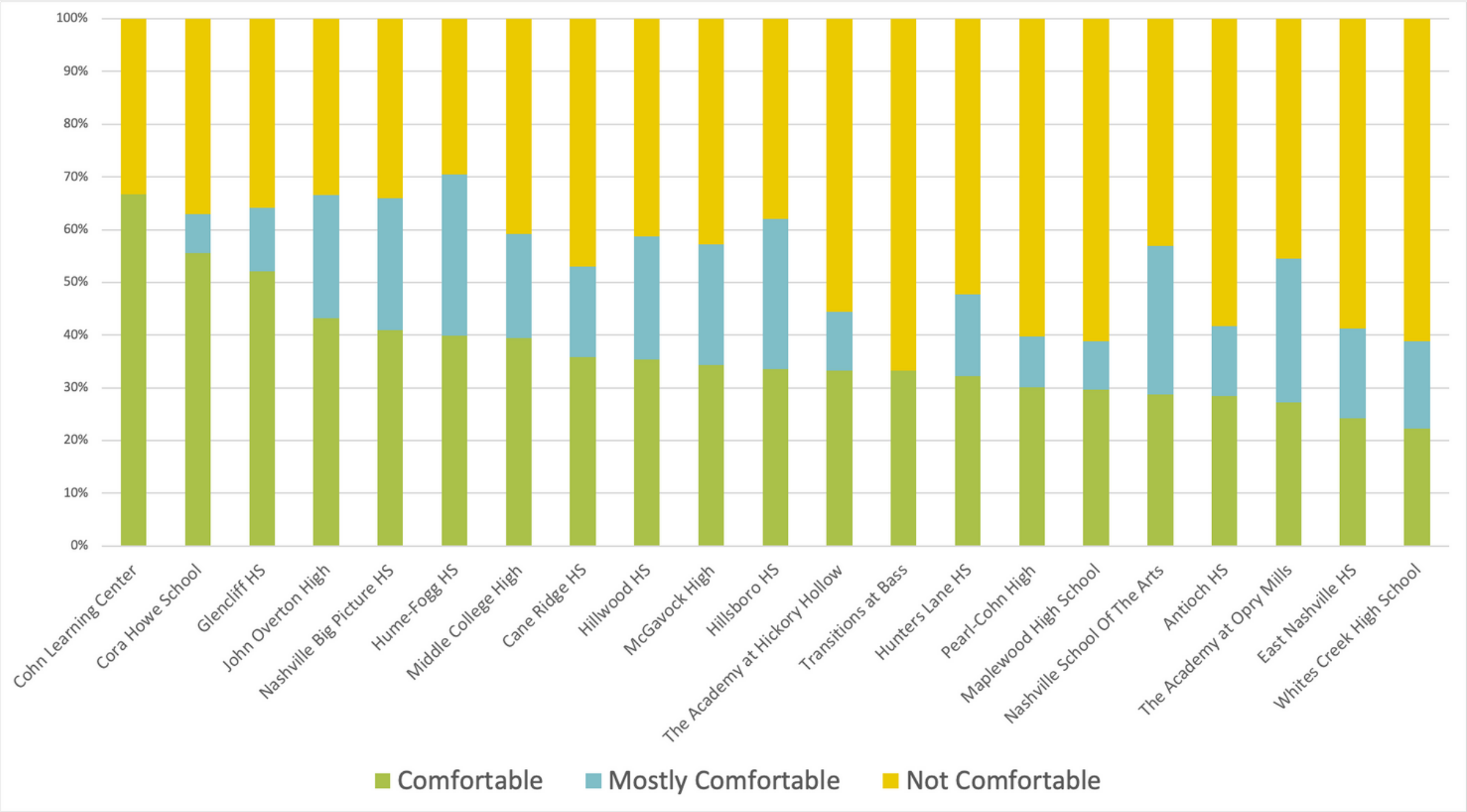

Breakdown by Middle Schools ( 4,612 responses)



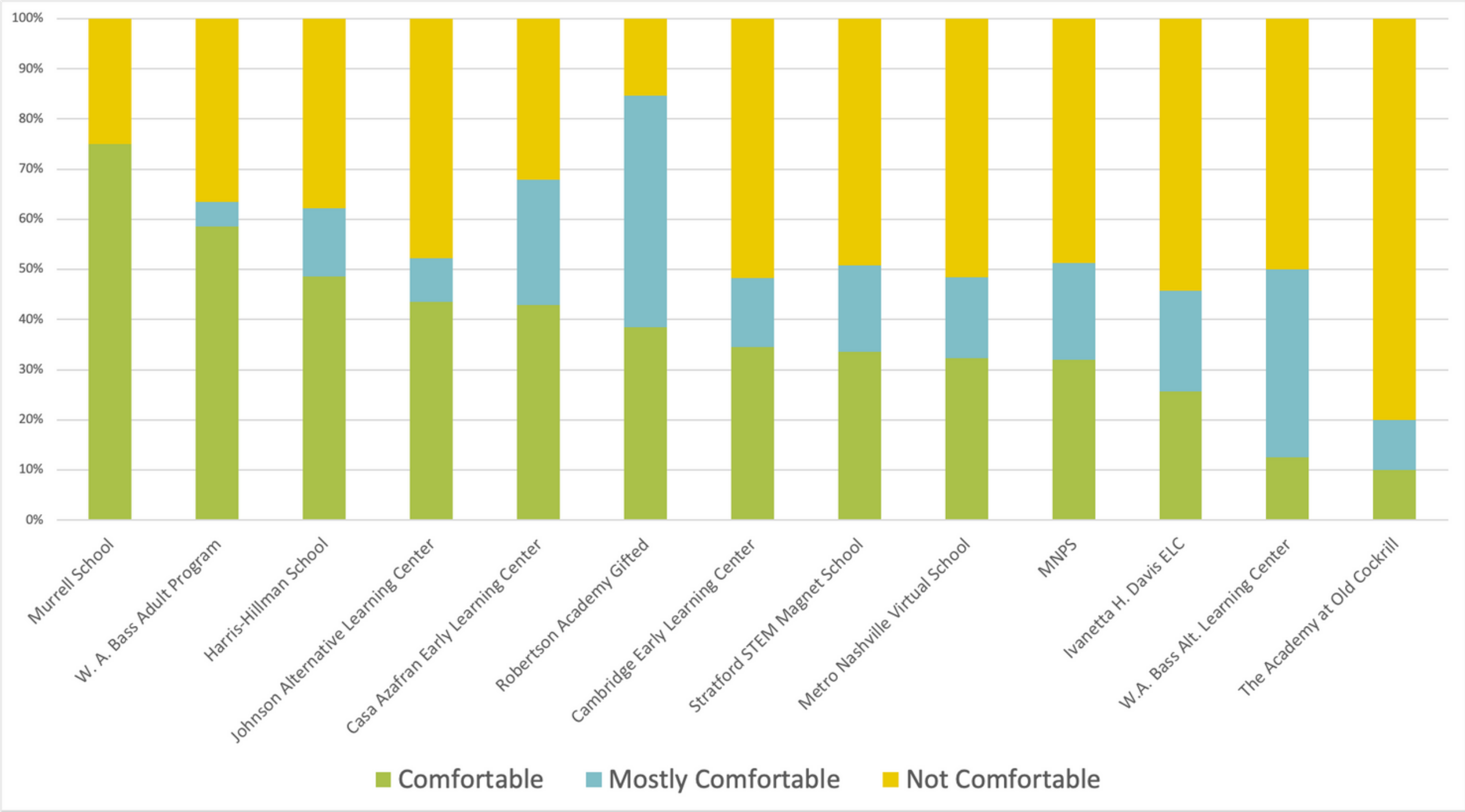
Given what you currently know, do you feel comfortable sending your child to school for in-person learning in August? Reply with YES, MOSTLY, or NO.

Breakdown by High Schools ( 3,531 responses)



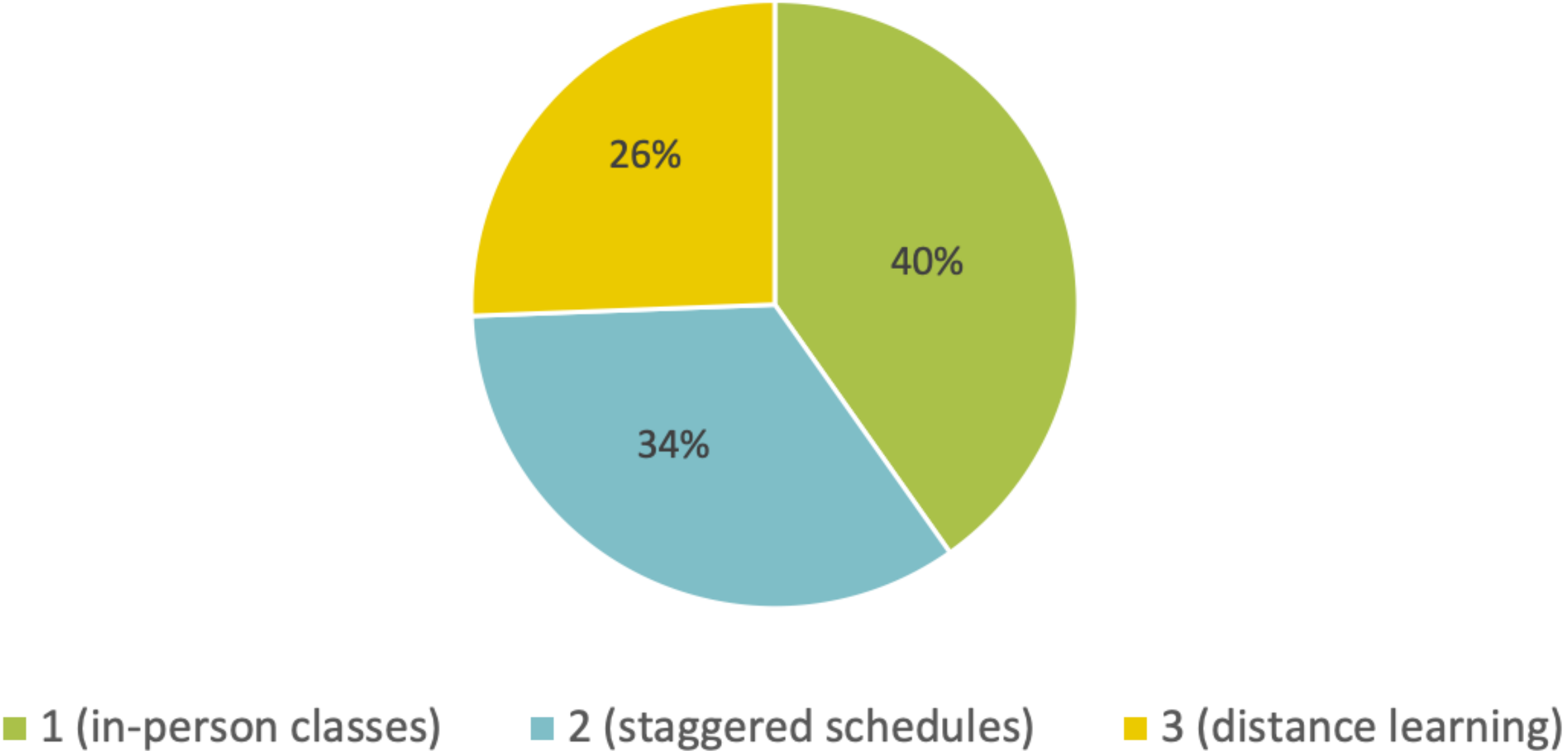

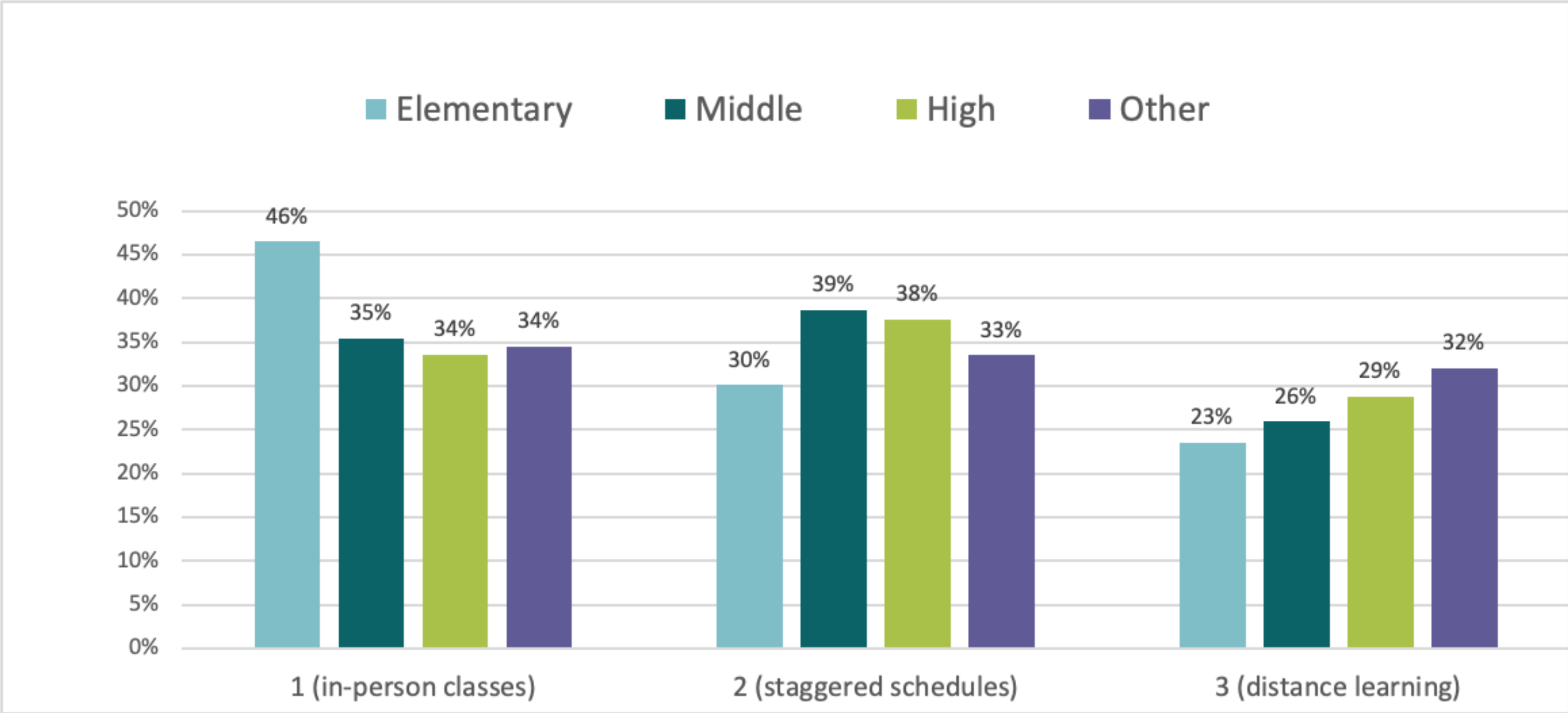

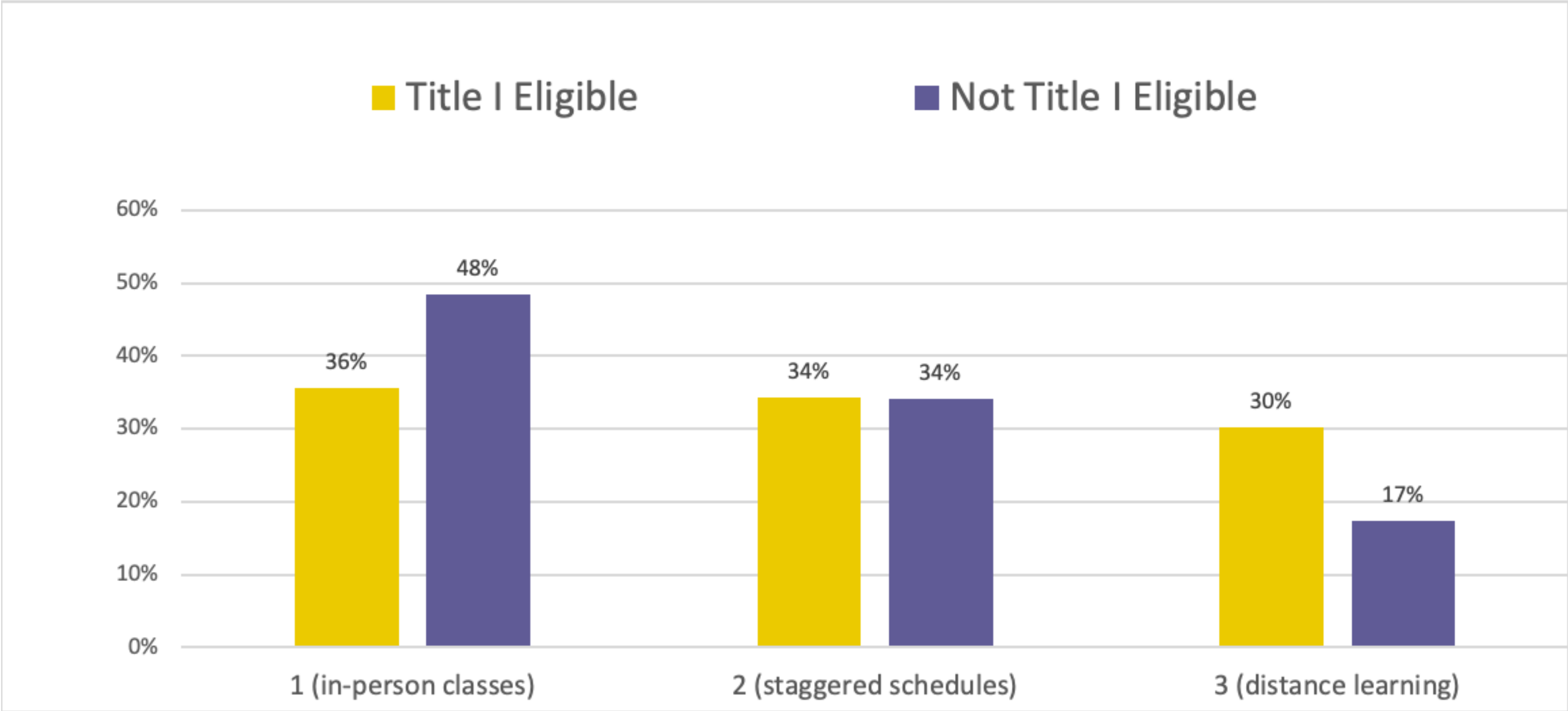
## Breakdown by School Level

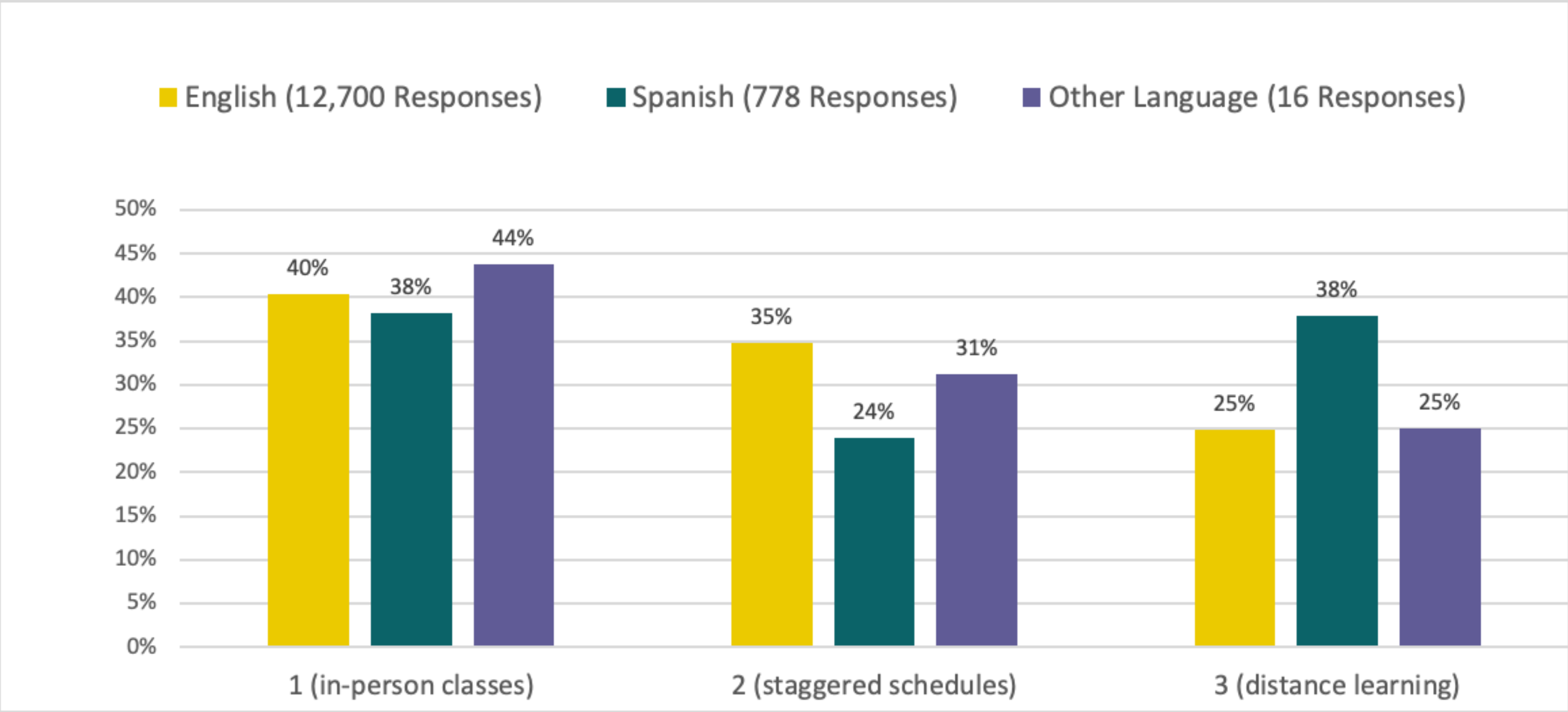

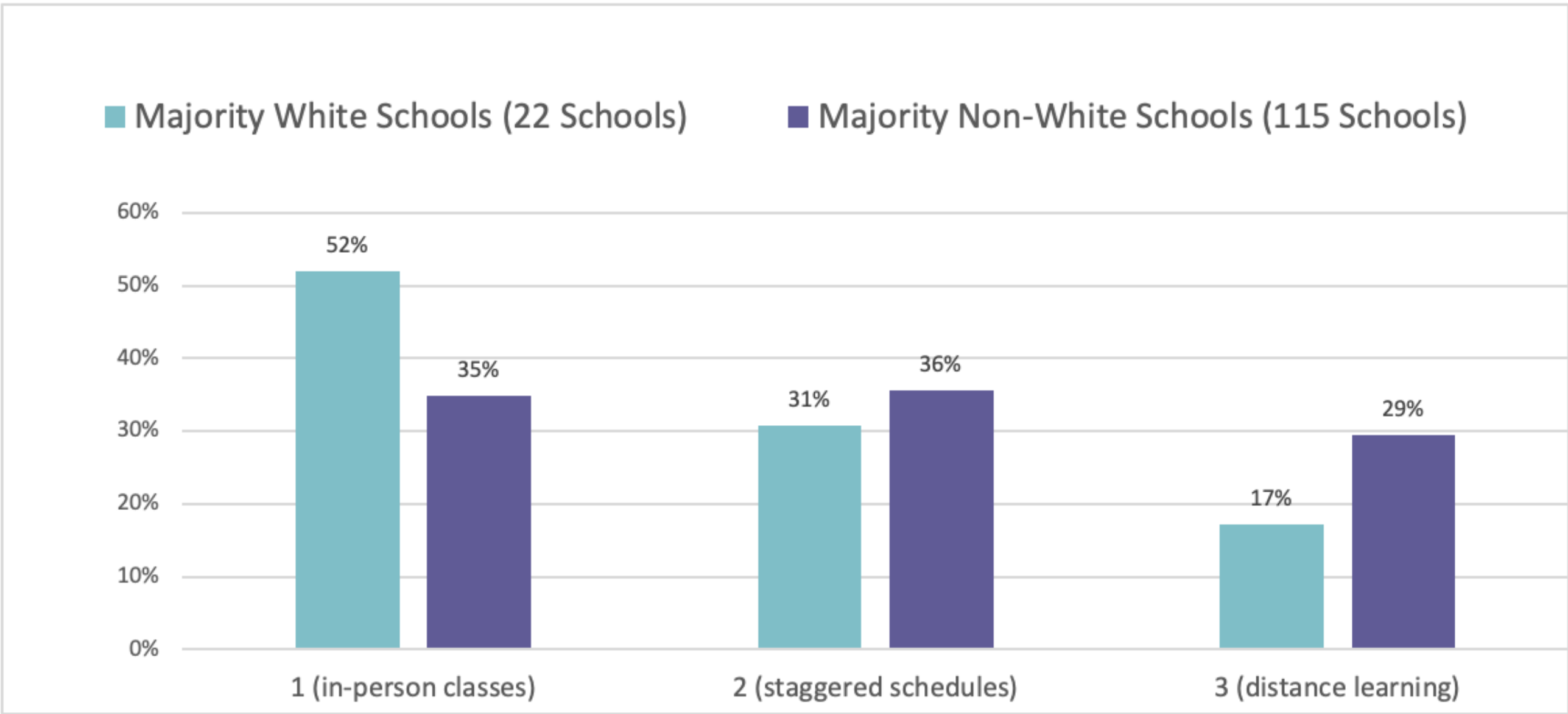

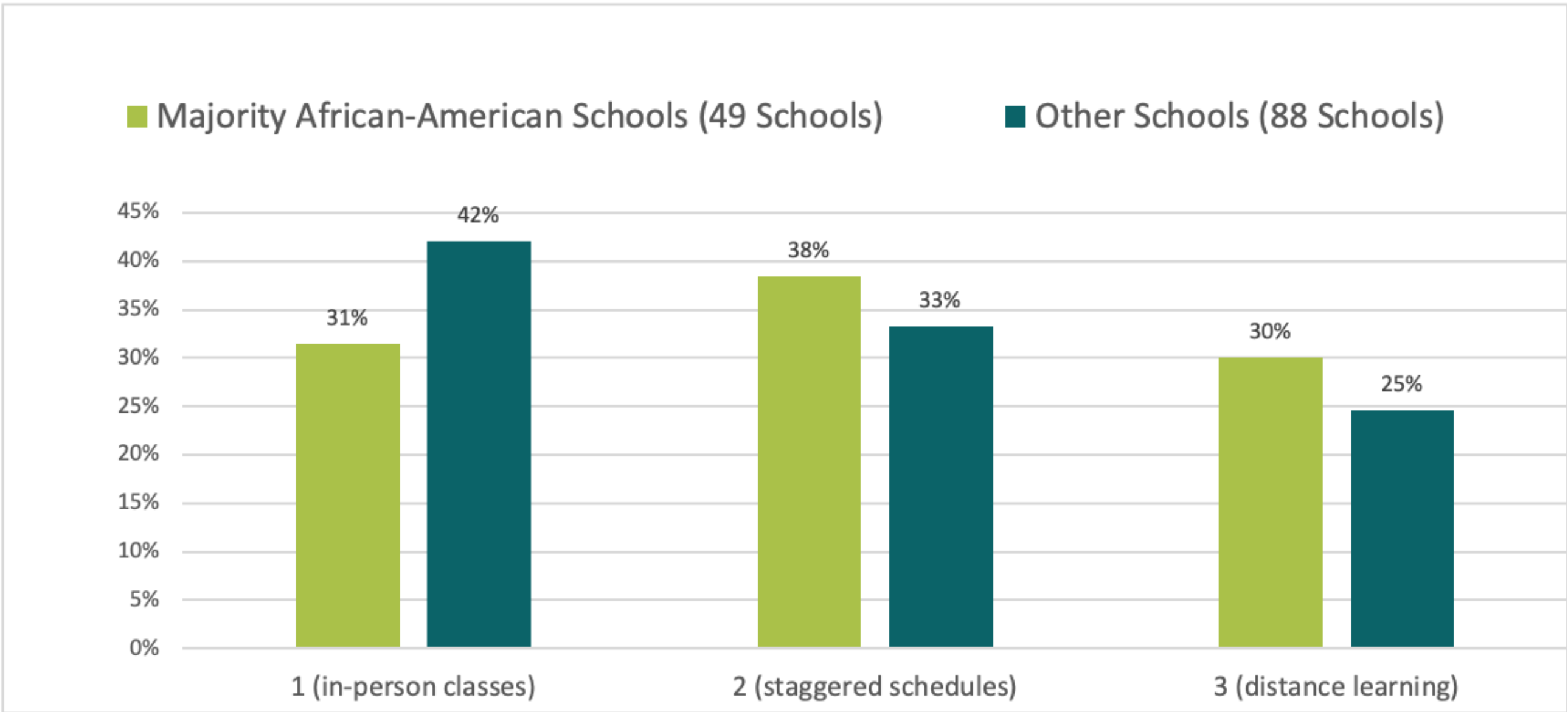

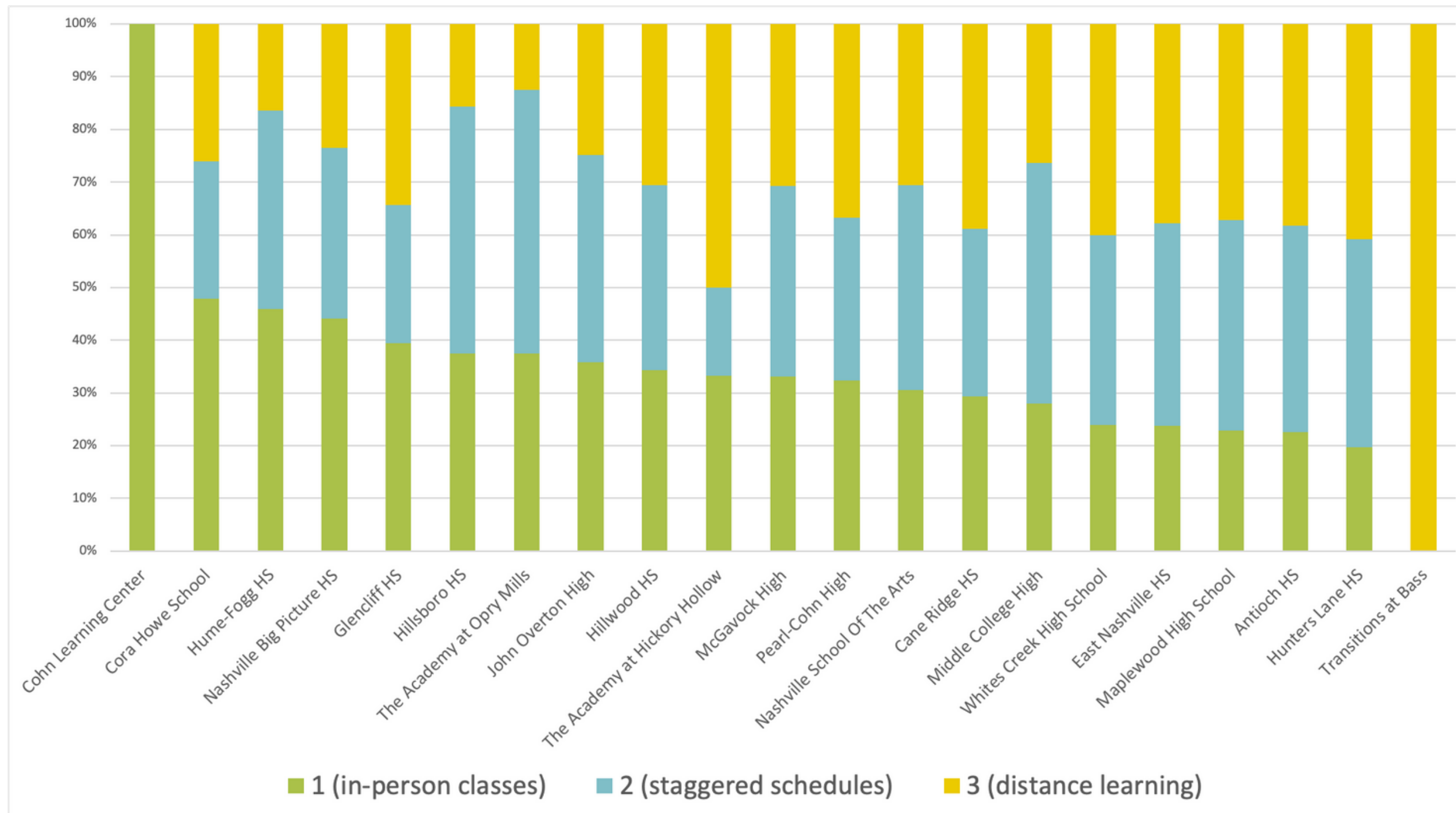
